A set of standard questions and common language developed by Philanthropy MA to make grantseeking easier and more efficient!

Why make the change?

The traditional approach to grant applications leads to widely varying applications across grant requests and organizations.

Standardized questions make it quicker and easier for grantseekers to apply and makes it easier for grantmakers to evaluate applications!





How will this impact grantseekers?

Standardizing grant application language and questions eases the burden on applicants, allowing them to apply to more grants and to focus their energy on making a difference.
